

- AEDES SIIQ JOINS TO EPRA CONFERENCE 2017

Milan 5 September 2017 – The Management of **Aedes Siiq S.p.A.** (MTA: AE.MI) will take part from today to 7th September to the EPRA Conference 2017, annual conference of all listed European real estate companies. At "The Landmark Hotel" in London will host 3 days of round-up meetings and round tables among the top managers of all European listed EPRA companies associated with EPRA.

Aedes, which was founded in 1905 and listed in 1924, was the first real estate company listed on the Milan Stock Exchange (MTA:AE.MI). The strategy of the Company, which became a REIT on 1 January 2016, is to create and maintain in the medium term, a real estate portfolio used for commercial purposes, which generates cash flows consistent with the REIT model. Recurring cash flows will come from the retail and office properties already owned, which are currently rented assets or being sold, and from in house areas developed for the construction of rented property used above all for retail purposes.
